The building permit costs \$750 when issued to cover all inspection fees associated with building; however, there may be additional costs incurred if there are extenuating circumstances. Applications are available at the Town Office. Appointments to meet with Zoning Officer John Pianka are arranged through Mary Smith at the Town Office (603)648-2272. An **impact fee of \$5,306** will also be assessed at the time of issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy. More info under “Sewer” regarding septic designs.

Sewer – individual. Must now be approved by the Town’s Soil Scientist prior to being submitted to the State. This requires five (5) sets of plans to be submitted to the Town (fee included with the building permit fee) and a check to DES for \$300 with a pre-addressed stamped envelope so that it can be mailed directly to the State.

Tax Rate 2008 – \$18.71 – Billing is done semi-annually. (Annual tax rate is set prior to the December billing). Tax year is April 1 – March 31, which is what your “Inventory of Taxable Property” is based on, which must be filed annually by April 15th. Failure to file this form timely will result in a penalty on your second tax bill as allowed under RSA 74:7-a equal to 1% of the property tax, and not less than \$10 or more than \$50. Late filing may result in the loss of the right to appeal the property tax assessment.

Town Meeting – second Tuesday in March. It is mandatory to hold a public hearing for the Warrant and Budget at least 25 days prior to the Town Meeting (historically this has been the second Tuesday in February). Town reports are available approximately one week before the Town Meeting.

Zone – Agricultural/Residential. Minimum lot size is five acres with 250’ frontage required on the road that services it. Those with lots between 4 and 9.9 acres may sub-divide that property into 2 lots with and a minimum of 2 acres per lot and a minimum of 250’ frontage each. (Pillsbury Lake District is pre-existing, non-conforming to Zoning – prior to 1974 and is zoned residential only). Setbacks are 50’ from sides and rear boundary lines, and 100’ from the Road, except in Pillsbury Lake they are 12’ sides and 20’ front & rear. Setback from water is 50’.
